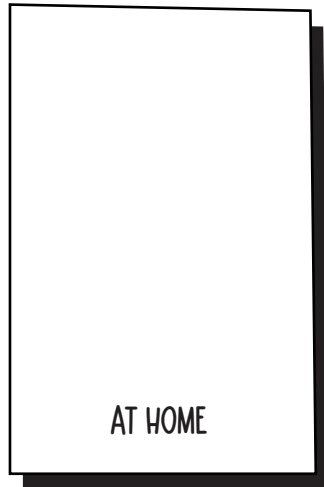

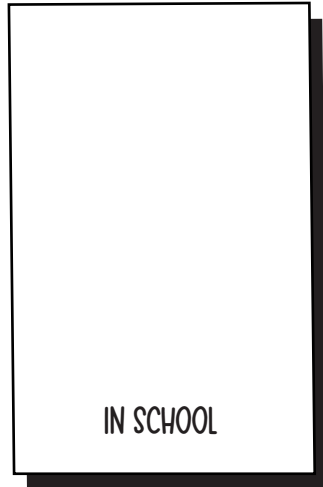

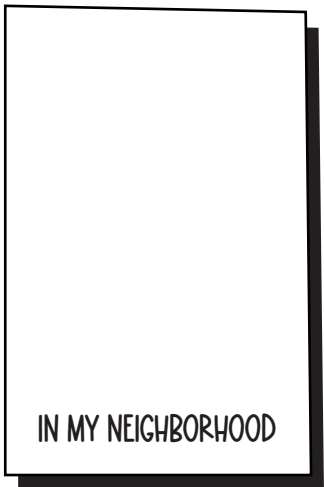
Think about something you can do to obey God and show you are set apart in each situation. Draw a picture and see how quickly your friend can guess what you're doing.



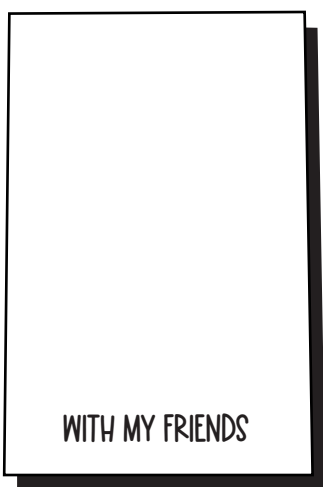

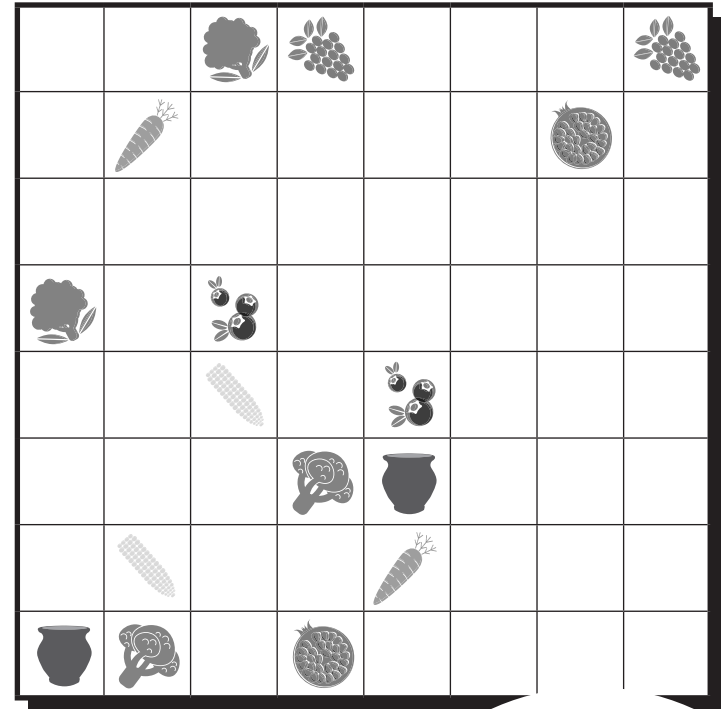

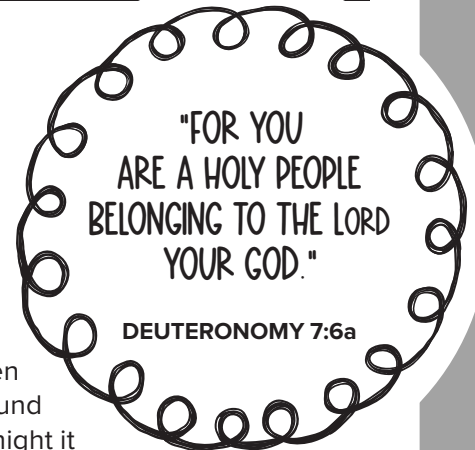
THIS MONTH'S TRUTH: I Am Set Apart
